# Use Case #1

**Q** I cannot find my group because the group name and list are long

**A** You can search for alias name when editing Group Alias Picker field

**Tip:** You can search any part of the group name, it need not necessarily be start of the word

# Use Case #2



**Q** I cannot find my group because the group names are similar and confusing

**A** Jira Admin can map the group name to an alias name that user can understand

Group Alias Mapping:

ORG_HQ_IT_DEV_USERS	HQ L2 Support
ORG_HQ_IT_EXTHELPDESK_USERS	HQ Vendor Support
ORG_HQ_IT_EXT_USERS	HQ Vendor
ORG_HQ_IT_HELPDESK_USERS	HQ L1 Support

**Tip:** Different alias can be given to the same group under different field context



# Use Case #3



I want "IT Security" to represent different set of group members for projects used by different countries in the organisation



The "IT Security" option can be mapped to a different underlying group such as:

- ORG\_SG\_IT\_SEC\_USERS
- ORG\_US\_IT\_SEC\_USERS
- ORG\_JP\_IT\_SEC\_USERS

# Use Case #4

- Q** I want to rename the groups because some departments are renamed after reorganisation
- A** Jira Admin can change the alias name to match the new department name

# Use Case #5



- Q** I cannot grant browse user permission for security reasons, but the end user needs to select Jira group
- A** Browse user permission is not required to select groups with the Group Alias Picker custom field type

**Tip:** You can use Group Alias picker in permission and notification schemes, just like Jira Group Picker

Can select a different alias for the group name			✓
Can filter the options for selection		✓	✓
Does not require browse user permissions		✓	✓
Can appear in the <b>People</b> section in the issue view	✓		✓
Can be used for notification schemes	✓	✓	✓
Can be used for permission schemes	✓	✓	✓
