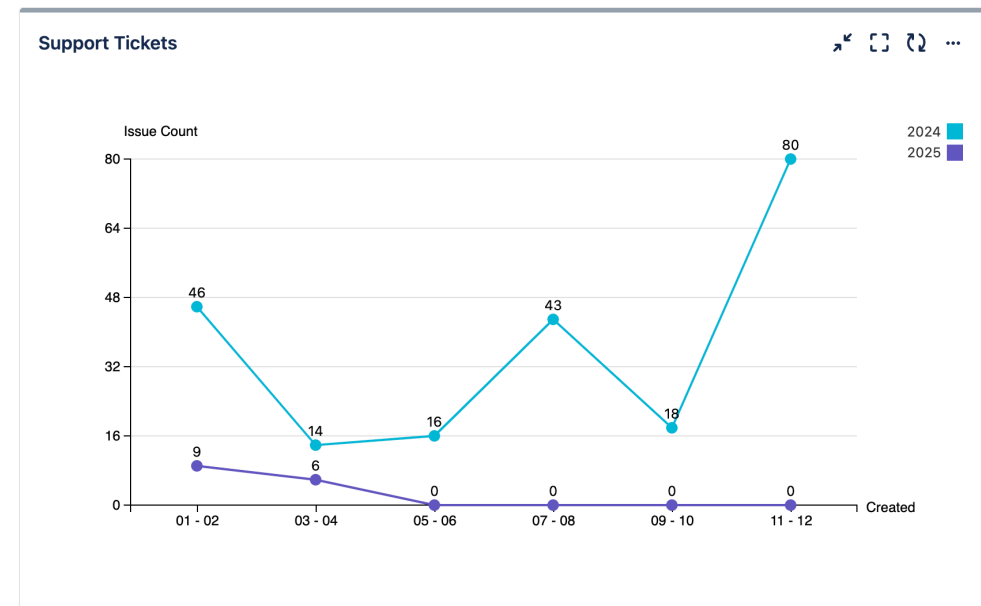
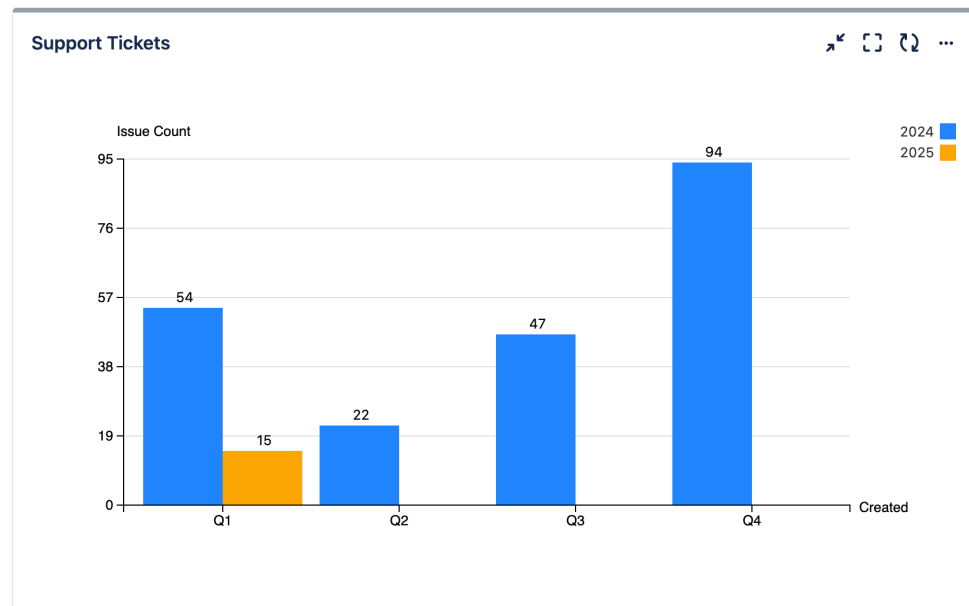

Tip:

You can change the **Period Format** and **Months in Groups** to group issues in months, quarters or halves

# Use Case #2

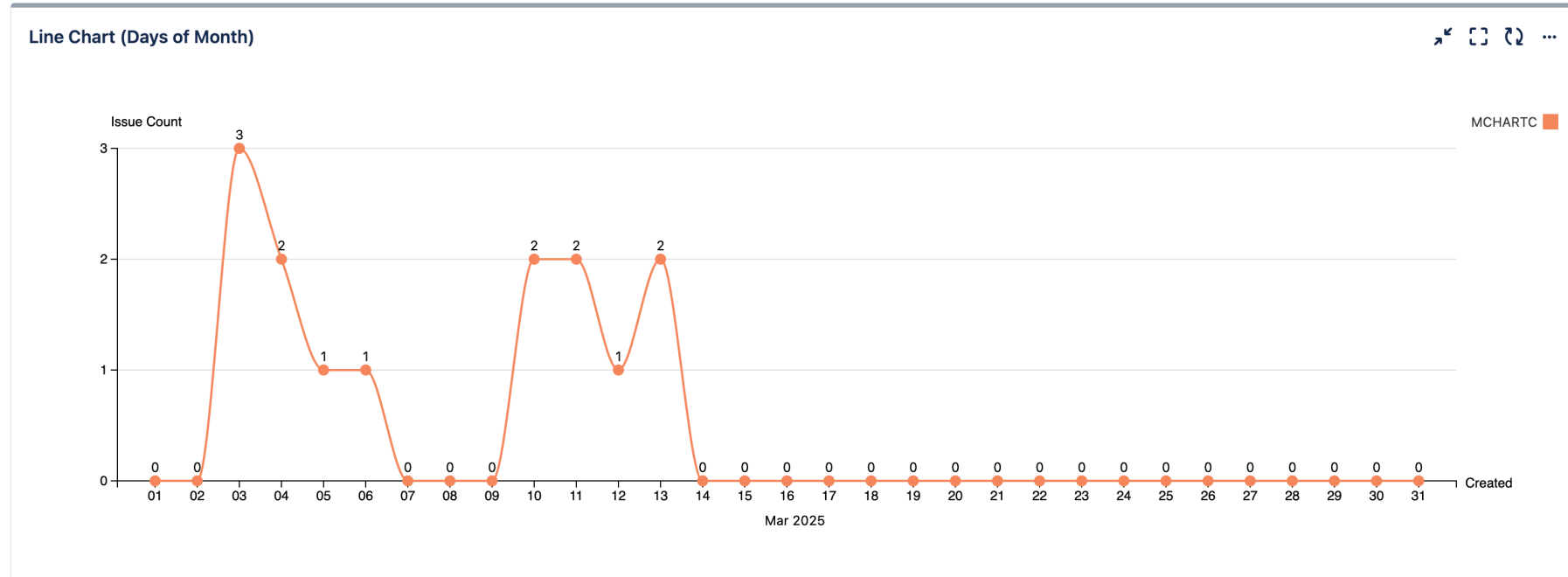

I want to view a report for all the days in the month

A

[Multiple Filters Line Chart Gadget \(Days of Month\)](#)



**Tip:** You can view the current/previous month automatically

# Use Case #3

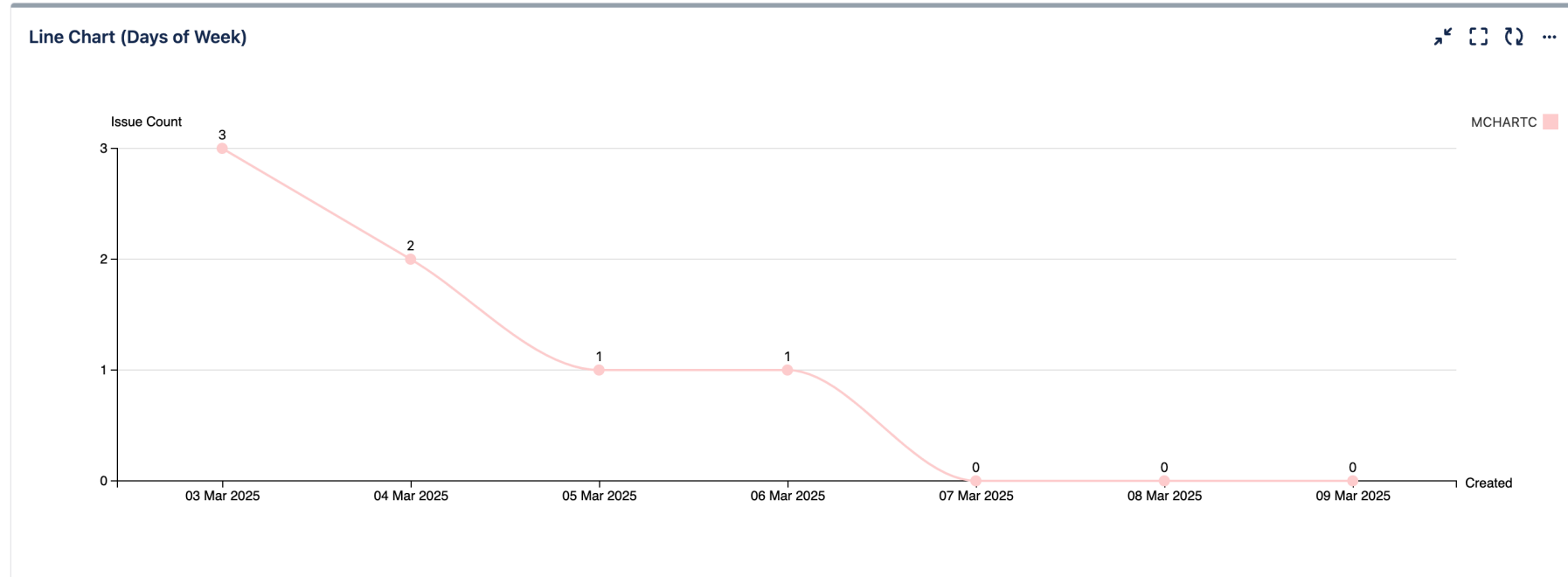


Q

I want to view a report for all the days in the week

A

[Multiple Filters Line Chart Gadget \(Days of Week\)](#)



**Tip:** You can change the **First Day of Week** (e.g. your weekly sprint starts on a Wednesday)

# Use Case #4

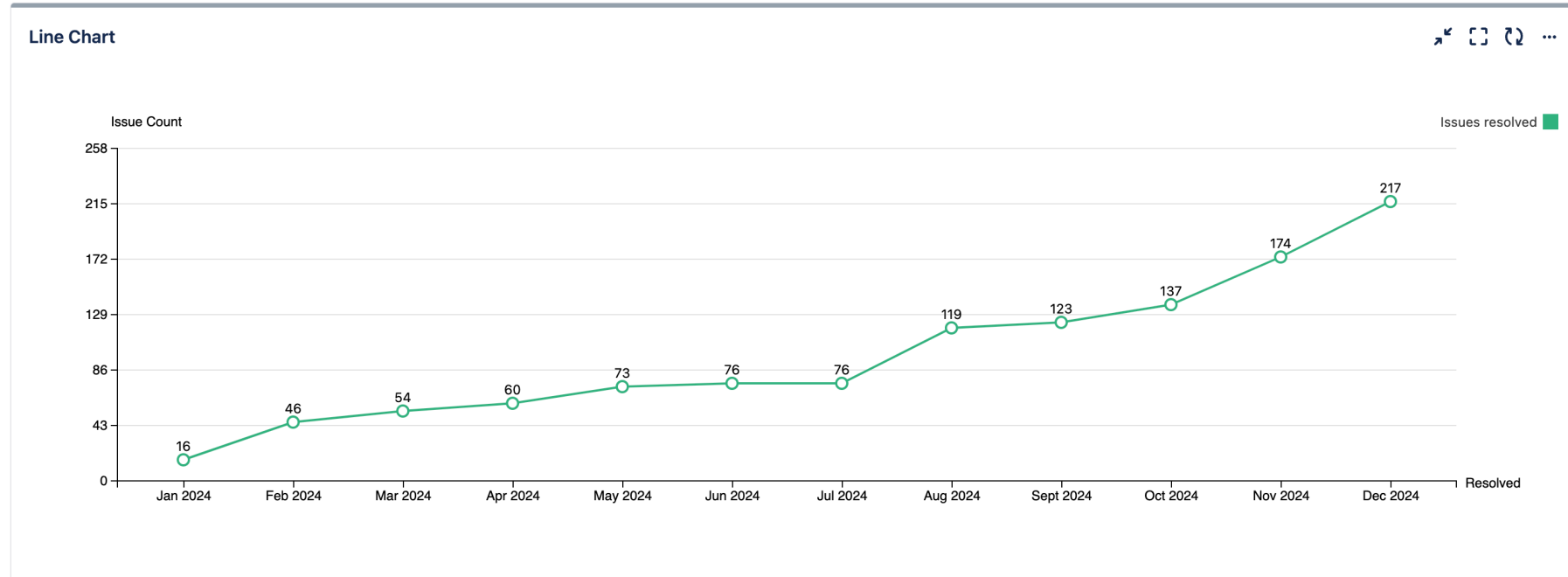

I want to see the total number of issues resolved year-to-date (YTD)

Tip:

You can also choose to chart the **cumulative** sum of Story Points as a Burnup Chart

# Use Case #5

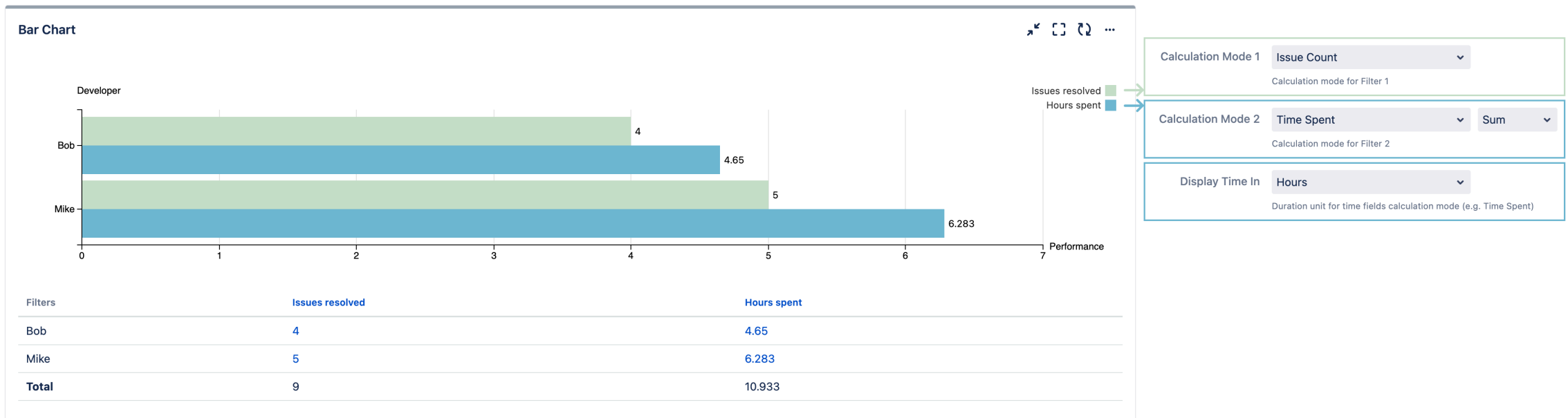

As a project manager, I want to view the performance of each developer in the current sprint

Multiple Filters Statistic Bar Chart Gadget (Horizontal)



**Tip:**

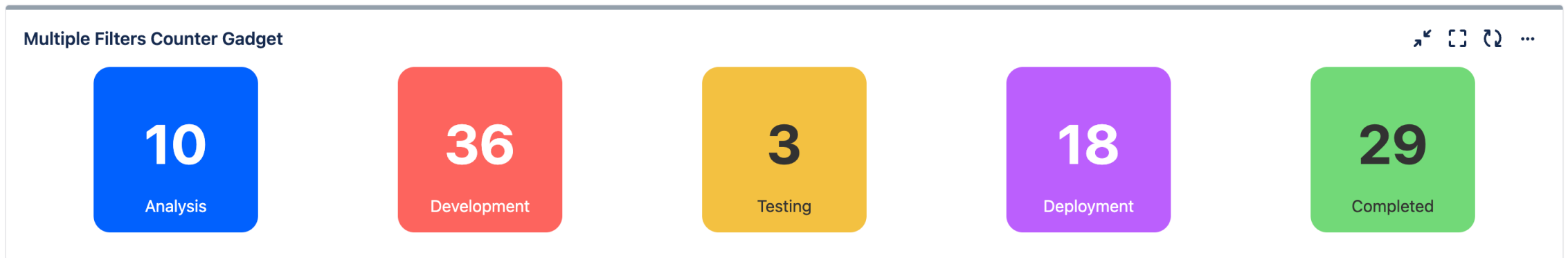
You can track **different types of metrics** (issue count, story points, time or numeric custom fields) using separate filters

**Q** I want to track multiple metrics within a single gadget

**Tip:** It is also possible to [set the background colour automatically based on the value](#)

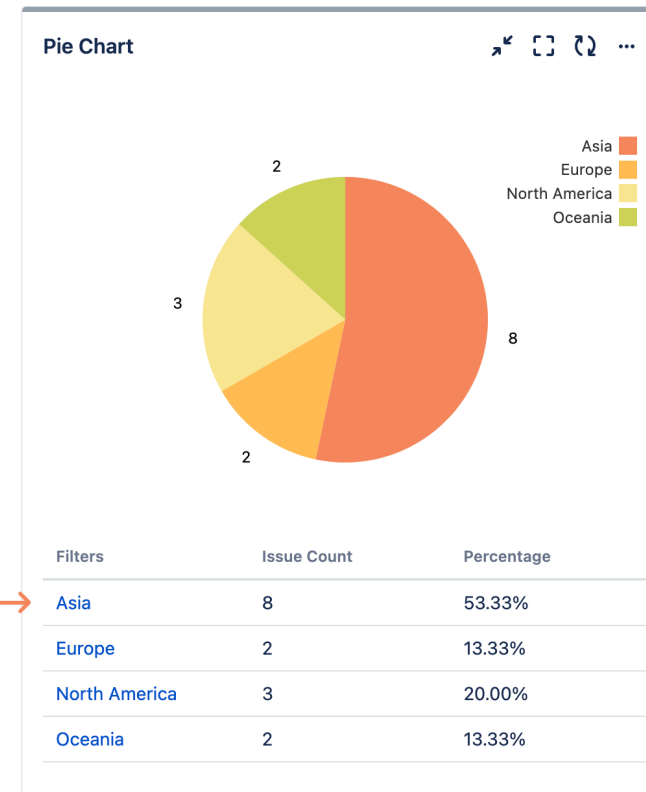

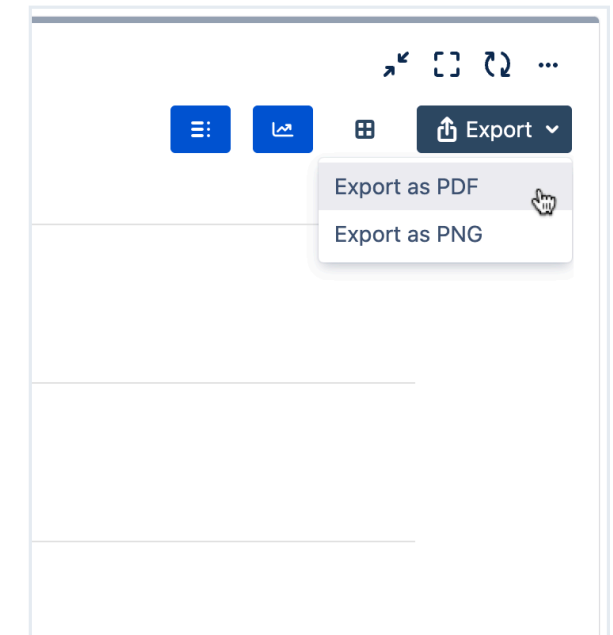
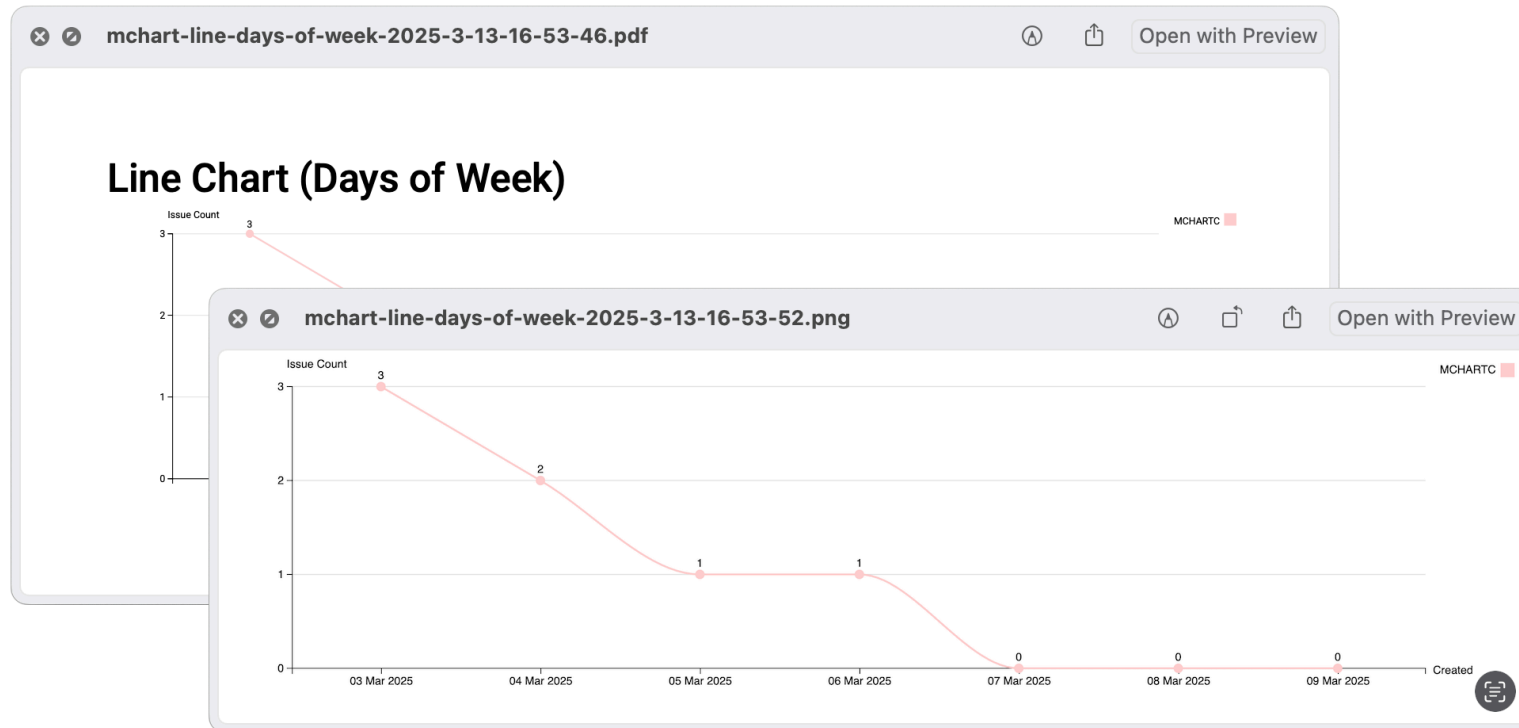

# Use Case #9

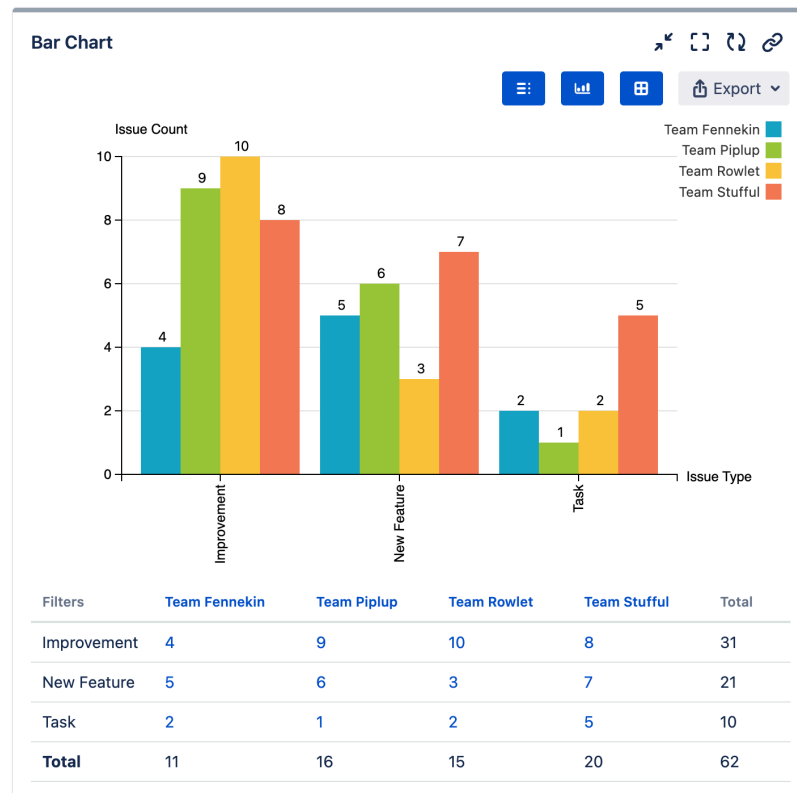


Q

Click on the chart and table icon to show/hide the view

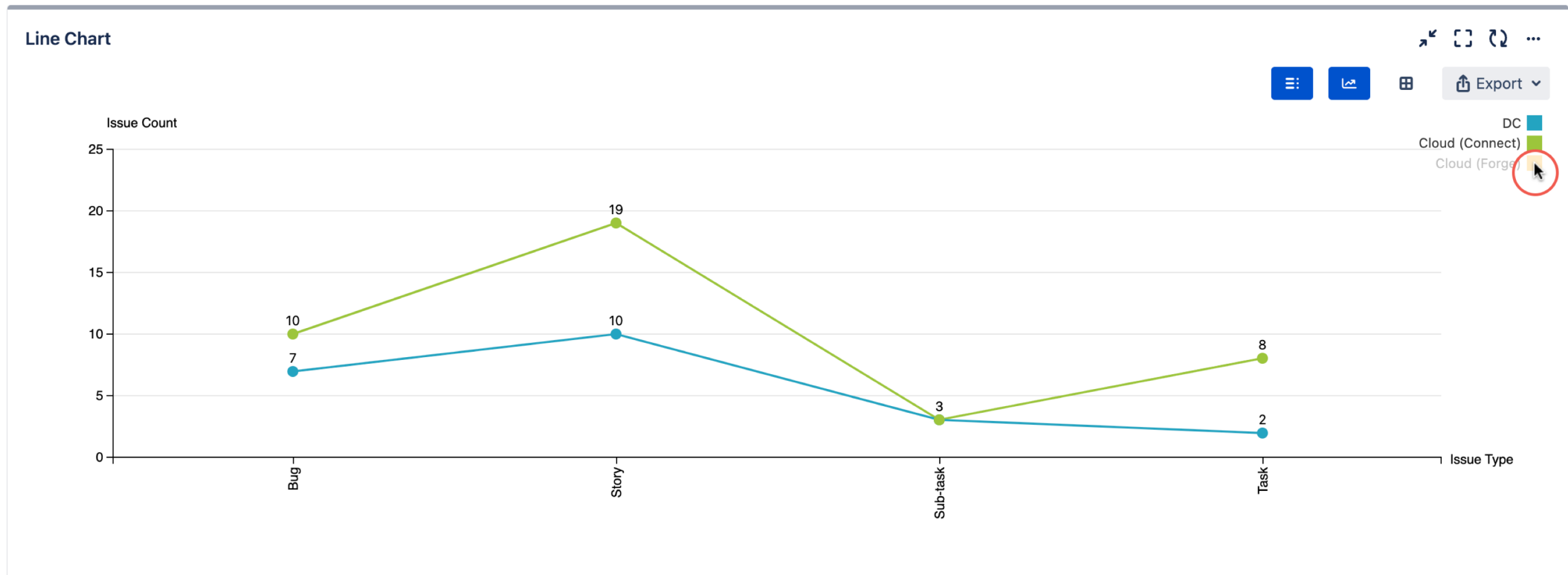

I want to use JQL as the data source rather than creating additional filters

Switch to the JQL tab and click on the input field, a JQL Editor will popup for users to enter JQL

[Dashboard Assistant](#) enables users to schedule email reminders for subscribers to review Jira dashboard reports. The app helps collaboration & timely reviews with features that allow users to post comments and perform check-ins.



[Gauge Gadget](#) is a collection of gadgets that allow users to see at one glance the issue count or number/time values of issues in a filter, and to see if it is reaching or has exceeded the given threshold.



[Tissue](#) provides a master view of related issues in a tabular format.
